



## Thomas Sie McNeff

July 17, 1944 - February 22, 2023

Thomas Sie McNeff passed away on February 22, 2023, at the age of 79. He was born to Thomas Verdie McNeff and Beulah June McNeff on July 17, 1944, in Bartlesville, Oklahoma.

Upon graduating high school, he served four years in the United States Navy then reenlisted in the Airforce for another three years. He was honored to serve his country in two different branches of service. He worked for Haliburton Services for about thirteen years.
