Rogers, Thomas Clayton, 80, retired banker and Bartlesville resident, passed away May 29, 2016.

Tom was born in Shreveport, LA to parents Roy L. and Mary Louise (Robbins) Hall on February 15, 1936. He attended schools in Mt. Vernon, IL and graduated from there in 1954.
