Tony M. Wyatt Sr., age 63, spouse of Mary Jane passed away June 21, 2013. Tony, son of the late Charles and Evelyn (Emerson) Wyatt, was born February 12, 1950, in Miami, OK.

Funeral services for Tony will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 25, at the Stumpff Funeral Home, 1600 SE. Washington, Bartlesville, OK with burial at Memorial Park Cemetery, 4200 Nowata Rd, Bartlesville, OK. Full Military Honors will be presented at the graveside by James H. Teel, American Legion Post #105.

Tony grew up and graduated in Commerce, OK. Tony enjoyed playing baseball, football, and basketball. He received his Associates degree from NEO in 1970, attended Missouri Southern in 1971, and graduated with his Bachelor's degree from Pittsburg State in 1972.

Tony married Mary Jane Smith in Tulsa, OK July 31, 1972. Tony volunteered the draft in 1972. Tony was stationed at the Pentagon, Washington, D.C. from 1972 - 1974. In August of 1974, Tony began his career with Phillips Petroleum Company located in Bartlesville, OK. Tony completed his Masters at Tulsa University in 1978. Tony and Mary moved their family to Albuquerque, NM in October 1980 where Tony worked for Phillips Uranium and in July 1982 moved to Littleton, CO, where he continued working for Phillips Minerals. In late 1982 he accepted a position back in Bartlesville where he continued to work for Phillips/ConocoPhillips as a Computer Analyst until he retired in February 2010.

Tony enjoyed many things, but had a keen interest in finances and spent many hours working on their portfolio. He kept up to date with the markets and read money market analysis magazines. He also enjoyed spending time with his family; Tony was a great husband, father, and grandfather. One of his favorite saying's was "It's not worth anything until you sell it." Tony liked playing cards and had many fun trips to Nevada with his buddies from work and the Solo. Tony gave it his all to overcome his disabilities due to a stroke and always said when I get better I'm going to... He had many fine caregivers... Tony and Mary Jane appreciated their help, along with his main doctors; Dr. Reed and Dr. Defehr. JP Home Health... Raul Vasquez was our rock for therapy. Tony and Mary Jane have the best son's and family who have been with them on this final journey. We thank God for the strength and guidance we have depended on.

Tony Wyatt Sr. is survived by his wife of 40 years, Mary Jane Wyatt of Bartlesville; two sons Tony Jr. and wife Jackie and Trevor and wife Tosha. Three grandchildren, Triston Thomas (15), Mallory McKay (10) and Becker Emery (2). He was looking forward to two additional grandchildren. He is survived by his sister, Pat Abernathy and husband Chuck of Independence, MO. Tony is survived by many nieces and nephews.
