Tracy Lynn Rohleder, 57, of Bartlesville, died at 6:35 A.M. on Monday, September 19, 2016 at her home following a five year battle with cancer. Memorial services for Tracy will be held at 2 P.M. on Saturday, October 1, 2016 in the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel. Cremation arrangements were under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home and Crematory. Following the memorial services, a Celebration of Tracy's Life will be held at Sterling's Grille, located at 2905 S.E. Frank Phillips Blvd., in Bartlesville and those who attend are asked to bring a donation of dog food for the Washington County SPCA. She grew up and received her education in Phoenix, Arizona where she graduated from high school and also attended Arizona State University where she graduated with a Bachelor's degree in Logistics Management. She was employed with Tosco Petroleum at Tempe, Arizona until transferring to Bartlesville with Conoco/Phillips in 2003 where she was a financial analyst and then with Phillips 66 until discontinuing her work in 2015 due to her illness. She was married to Steve Rohleder at Owasso, Oklahoma in October 2003 and they

have made their home in Bartlesville since that time. She loved to play water volleyball and was an avid animal lover. She was one of the original board members of the Cooper Dog Park and an active volunteer with the Washington County SPCA. She also enjoyed spending time with her friends and granddaughters.

Tracy is survived by her husband, Steve Rohleder of the home, one daughter, Meghan Franks and husband Chance of Bartlesville, her mother, Nancy Krieger of Phoenix, Arizona, two granddaughters, Bayleigh Hadley and Mekayla Franks, and all of her four legged friends.

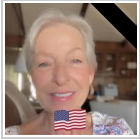
