Truett Hendricks, 86, passed away January 25, 2019, in Okmulgee, OK. Truett was born on February 2, 1932, in Dover, AR, to parents Steven A. and Floy (Hilderbrand) Hendricks. Truett grew up and attended school in the Copan, OK area.

On January 13, 1951, he married Elsie Mae Dyer in Sebastian, AR. She preceded him in death on October 26, 2006.

Truett as a young adult worked as a roustabout for the Barber Oil Company. He then got his insurance license and sold policies for Metropolitan Life Insurance. In the early 1960's, Truett bought a farm in Nowata County and also joined the Bartlesville Fire Department, where he retired as Captain after 30 years of service.

Truett loved being outdoors. He enjoyed a good day's work on his farm, and he had a lifelong love of horses. He enjoyed riding and training horses. Truett was an expert at buying and selling farm equipment and enjoyed making deals. Truett was also an avid hunter and enjoyed deer hunting and especially liked to go elk hunting in the Colorado Mountains, which he would do by horseback and pack mule.

On December 29, 2014, Truett wed Jerolene Dearmore in Ft. Smith, AR. Truett is survived by his wife, Jerolene, of the home; and a son Robert Hendricks and wife Terri of Checotah, OK; and daughter Cynthia Garrett and husband Gary of Bartlesville, OK; as well as a host of other friends and relatives.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his first wife, Elsie; two sisters, Betty Jane Nichols and Izola Shirley; and a brother, Steve Hendricks, Jr.
