Ty Riley Marvin, 39, of Bernice, Oklahoma died Tuesday, March 1, 2022. Ty was born September 14, 1982, to parents Tommy Marvin and the late Debra Lynn (McPherson) Marvin, in Gravette, Arkansas. He graduated from Gravette High School. After high school, Ty served our country in the United States Navy, and was honorably discharged.

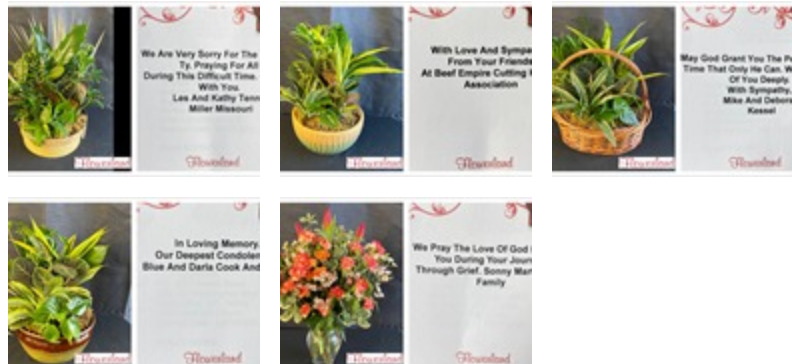
