She was also remembered for her innovative birthday parties at their home. Several times the Sapulpa Herald came out to take pictures as the children celebrated a Peter Pan party, a circus party and many other creative events. She also worked at the Summer Day Camp Okiwanee She worked as a seamstress designing and making costumes for the Tulsa Junior Dance

Ballet during the 1960's and 1970's. Mrs. Morrison accepted Christ into her life as a teenager. She was baptized at Ardmore First United Methodist Church at the age of 80. She was preceded in death by her husband Charles Morrison; an infant daughter Linda and her parents Cleo and Vertie Beard. Marie is survived by her two daughters and their husbands: Cheryl and Dan Patman of Ardmore, Oklahoma; Debbie and Clyde Rupert of Plano, Texas.
