



## Vickie Rae Doughty

January 2, 1943 - September 13, 2025

Vickie Rae Doughty (née Mease), 82, of Bartlesville, Oklahoma, passed from her earthly life and into her Heavenly existence on September 13, 2025, after a rich life fully lived.

Vickie was born on January 2, 1943 to Julius Van and Ruth Mease (née Barker) in Pasadena, Texas. After graduating from Nowata (OK) High School, she went to work for Phillips Petroleum Company in Bartlesville. She worked both in and out of the home for most of her adult life, delicately balancing being a wife and mom with working in a variety of settings in a clerical/ office assistant capacity, including working for former Chief of the Cherokee Nation, William Keeler, working for her church, medical practices, and various law firms.

In September of 1966, Vickie met Daryl Doughty at a young singles mixer at the YWCA in Bartlesville, and after a brief courtship, they were married at Redeemer Lutheran Church on July 7, 1967. Vickie and Daryl went on to have two children, Stefan Kent Doughty and Kyle Edward Doughty.

The two most important things in life to Vickie were her faith in God and her family - including those from blood, marriage, or simple relationship, and she quietly yet ceaselessly worked to make sure all knew how important those things were to her. She enjoyed traveling, occasional trips to local casinos,

and shopping on QVC, but her heart was always with her family and in her home in Bartlesville, even having lived briefly in each of Norman, Lawton, and Vinita, Oklahoma.

Vickie was preceded in death by her parents, Julius Van and Ruth Muriel, both of Nowata, Oklahoma, and one, younger brother, Michel Kent Mease, of Bixby, Oklahoma. She is survived by her husband, Daryl, her son, Stefan and his wife, Amanda, of Yukon, Oklahoma, her son Kyle and his wife, Ashlyn, of Dallas, Texas, her grandchildren, Madison Longan (née Doughty), Austin, Preslea, Kobie, and Landry Doughty, her great grandchildren, Archer and Wilder Longan, and her brother, Van Edward Mease and his wife, Becca, of Wichita, Kansas, and an extended family of nieces, nephews, cousins and other relatives.
