Wanda Faye Madden, 70, resident of rural Bartlesville, died Sunday at her home

Funeral services for Mrs. Madden will be held at 10:00 A.M. Wednesday January 25, at the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel, with Pastor Sherman Jaquess of the Matoaka Baptist Church officiating.
