Wanda June Parsons, 72, of Bartlesville, died Friday, May 10, 2019.

Wanda was born November 18, 1946 in Roby, Illinois to parents Charles Lively SR. and Verna Mae (Haymaker) Lively. She was a graduate of Coffeyville Community College and worked her entire life as a Registered Nurse. She worked in Kansas, California, Arkansas, Florida and Oklahoma. Wanda married Johnny Max Parsons on November 18, 1967. The most memorable and special times of her life was her marriage and the births of her children and grandchildren.

There were 4 things Wanda June Parsons (Lively) loved. First, was Jesus. He was her go to guy. Second, was her family. She loved us more than life itself. Third, were the casinos. She would go to relax, be with her casino buddies and laugh. Fourth, working. She worked her whole life and was always working to better her education. She worked for herself, she worked for her family and she worked for her casino money. When she wasn't working, she was working at her house. She worked at doing something every single day up until her daily nap time.... She did love her naps. At 72, she was working as an RN at Brookhaven Hospital where she ultimately passed away due to cardiac arrest.

She also enjoyed antique shopping, gardening and reading.

Wanda was preceded in death by two brothers (Wayne and David Lively); one sister (Sharon); mother (Verna) and father (Charles).

She is survived by her husband; two daughters; one son in law and two

grandchildren.
