Mrs. WanEtta Blair Endsley, 89, longtime Washington county area resident died September 5, 2011 in Dewey, Oklahoma.

Ray Sears, WanEtta's nephew, will be the officiant at the Oglesby (Steel Camp) Cemetery at 11:00 AM on Friday, September 9, 2011. Graveside services and cremation are under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

WanEtta Blair Endsley was born January 15, 1922, at her parents home outside Bartlesville. She was the daughter of the late Thomas H. Sears and Margaret Francis (Cunningham) Sears. She grew up and graduated high school in Ramona. She married Ernest Roy Blair in 1940 and traveled with him during WWII when he served in the Army Air Corps. After WWII she and Roy moved to Pasadena, Texas and she worked in the Texas Education

System. WanEtta and Roy retired and moved back to Bartlesville and Roy died in 1997 after a long illness. WanEtta married Clyde Endsley in 2001 and they were active participants at dances and church functions in the Bartlesville area. WanEtta enjoyed music all of her life and played the piano and organ. She was a member of a dance group that entertained both senior citizens and children in the area. WanEtta was a member of the Cherokee Nation of Oklahoma and volunteered her time for tribal fund raisers to benefit Indian children.

Survivors include her husband, Clyde Endsley, son, Larry Blair and his wife Kathy, Bristow, Va., daughter, Gayla Heath and her husband, Jim, Roanoke, Va., four grandchildren, Rachel Arculin, Randall Blair, Chrystal Coleman and Melody Heath, and two great-grandchildren, Evan Arculin and Natalie Coleman.
