Funeral services for Mrs. Chew will be held at 2 P.M. on Wednesday, October 1, 2014 in the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel. Interment will be in the Memorial Park Cemetery directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory. Mrs. Chew was born at Ochelata, Oklahoma on May 23, 1909 the daughter of Robert Thomas Cary and Louise Anna (Jones) Cary. She moved to Bartlesville in November 1910 and she attended Butler Creek School. She was married to Oliver Delmer Chew on June 16, 1926 at the First Methodist Church Chapel in Bartlesville. Mr. and Mrs. Chew made their home in Bartlesville for all of their married life with the exception of a brief period in western Kansas. Mrs. Chew had worked at Lemmon's Grocery in Dewey, the Ideal Grocery in Bartlesville and the Tower IGA in Bartlesville. She was a member of the First Christian Church and was a 50 year member of the Order of Eastern Star. She was a wonderful mother and friend. She will be greatly missed.

Mrs. Chew is survived by two daughters, Peggy Collins and Betty Werts both of Bartlesville, one sister, Delma Pryce of Bartlesville, 9 grandchildren, 23 great grandchildren, and 19 great great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Oliver Delmer Chew on January 11, 1993, her son, Clyde (Bob) Chew, a daughter, Dell Micue, one granddaughter, Beth

Janes, one grandson, Lee Werts, and two sisters, Roberta Kean and Peggy (Johnston) Padgett.
