He enlisted on January 21, 1942 and was in the 5th Armored Division Troop A 85 Reconnaissance Squad. During his time in the service Bill received a Good Conduct Medal, American Service Ribbon, Distinguished Unit Badge, EAME Service Ribbon, one Silver Service Star and a Presidential Citation. Bill also fought in the Battle of the Bulge. He was honorable discharged on November 2, 1945. When Bill lived in Dallas he worked as a supervisor of production. He also worked for Tulsa Canvas Company as a bookkeeper. Bill married Maxine Downs on April 19, 1996. Bill has spent the last 16 years in Sperry where he was a member of the First Baptist Church. He is survived by his wife Maxine of the home, a daughter Sharon Reser of Collinsville; two grandchildren: Glen

and Wade Reser, great grandchildren Izzy and Glen, step child Claude Lewis of Owasso; step grandchildren: Daren Lewis, Kristie Wolf, Trina Driver, Anisa Lewis, step great grandchildren: Shannon Williams, Jeramiah Lewis, Denton Wolf, Morgan Wolf, step great great grandchildren: Hanna Williams, Addilyn Lewis, Alyssa Lewis, siblings: Louis Buck of Skiatook; Johnnie Buck of Broken Arrow and Ruth Yeamans of Skiatook.
