Mr. William Anthony "Tony" Dum, 63, of Bartlesville, died at 6:50 P.M. on Monday, July 17, 2017 in Tulsa.

The Funeral Mass will be held at 10 A.M. on Saturday, July 22, 2017 at the St. John Before The Latin Gate Catholic Church with Rev. John M. O'Neill officiating. Mr. Dum was born in Bartlesville, Oklahoma on August 8, 1953 the son of William Anthony and Mary Ann (Schneider) Dum. He grew up in Dewey and attended St. John Catholic School in Bartlesville through the eighth grade. He then attended Dewey Public Schools where he graduated from Dewey High School in 1971. He attended Central State University and then earned his certificate in computer aided drafting from Platt College. He had been a journeyman carpenter and has been a longtime employee of Flight Safety International in Broken Arrow where he was a Senior Computer Drafting Engineer.
