Mr. Wilmot (Bill) Newton Hewitt, Jr. 87, of Clarksville Arkansas, died at 9:55 p.m.,

Mr. Hewitt was born in Wann, Oklahoma on January 18, 1925 to Dovie (Royer) and

Wilmot Newton Hewitt Sr. He attended schools in the Nowata area. During World

War II, he served in the United States Navy as an electrician's mate third class on

the Destroyer Escort Ship, the U. S. S. Gilmore. He received an honorable

discharge from the United States Navy on December 23rd, 1945.

On March 2, 1946, he married Juanita Jean Riley and from this union they had four

children. He later married Mary Campbell and together they had one daughter.

Mr. Hewitt, during his life, worked as a mechanic, tool dresser, driller and an

electrician. He was a Federally licensed electrician and he retired as an electrician from Peabody Coal Company in 1978.

Mr. Hewitt enjoyed being outdoors and was an avid fisherman and hunter. He also

enjoyed teaching Sunday School. He loved the Lord, his family and friends.

Survivors include his wife of 46 years, Mary (Campbell) Hewitt of the home in

Clarksville, AR; one son: Bill; four daughters: Charlotte and her husband, Bill

Dausses, Virginia Kime, and Jeanie Hewitt all of Bartlesville, OK; Theresa and

her husband, Larry Johnson, of Clarksville, AR: nine grandchildren and eleven

great grandchildren.

Bill is also survived by one brother; Ernest and his wife, Peggy of Bartlesville, Ok;

three sisters: Elva Lunsford of Nowata, Ok; Marie Johnson and Goldie Hadley of
